



USEFUL INFORMATION FOR LIMOUSINE PASSENGERS

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO:

- › Agree the fare in advance;
- › A receipt upon completion of the journey;
- › A clean vehicle and a quiet journey;
- › Carriage of a guide dog or assistance dog; and
- › Reasonable assistance with luggage.



YOU ARE OBLIGED TO:

- › Pay the fare agreed;
- › Behave in a civil and orderly fashion;
- › Take care not to damage the vehicle or any sign or notice; and
- › Comply with any reasonable request made by the driver.

RECOGNISING A LICENCED DRIVER

The driver ID Card is displayed on the dashboard. It specifies:

- › the drivers name;
- › the driver's licence number; and
- › the driver's licence expiry date.

Purple and yellow Driver ID Cards are in operation.



RECOGNISING A LICENCED VEHICLE

A tamperproof licence disc is displayed on the front and rear windows. It specifies:

- › the vehicle licence number;
- › the vehicle registration number;
- › the number of passengers the vehicle is licenced to carry; and
- › the vehicle licence expiry date.



Check your driver and vehicle are registered with the NTA by using the **Driver Check App**. You can download the app free from the Apple App Store or Google Play stores.

The NTA is responsible for licensing the vehicles being driven and An Garda Síochána is responsible for issuing driver licences.
